We welcome **Jackie Hadwin** as our demonstrator this month. Jackie has painted with watercolour for about 25 years, taking an evening course with the late and very amazing Jill Aldersley, after which she was hooked and never looked back.

She now runs watercolour workshops from her Undercrag Studio in Torver, Cumbria. She has joined Made in Cumbria, attending a lot of outdoor events and exhibitions and has retail outlets for her cards and artwork. She finds her small business rewarding and very fulfilling. She also runs projects with the local primary school and youth groups.

Her enthusiasm for watercolour is infectious, she finds it an amazing medium probably one of the most difficult to work with, but its ability to move and mix on the paper is fascinating and addictive. When she paints she tries to capture the essence of the subject, always interested in creating an atmosphere and a connection to the viewer. Jackie's demonstration is entitled Animals in Watercolour & Pen; she is also leading a workshop the day after her demonstration.

**The session on 14th March is being extended to 6 hours** (10am – 4pm). We are very fortunate to have the opportunity to work alongside professional artist and teacher **Joe Hush** who has agreed to lead a workshop for the Group. This is open to anyone who would like to come along and will cost £5. Coffee, tea and biscuits are available. Bring a packed lunch if you wish.

Joe Hush was born in Northumberland but now lives in Washington, County Durham. He is a traditional landscape artist who likes to paint in Acrylic, Oils and Watercolour and has painted for pleasure for most of his life. The countryside of Northern England has certainly inspired him. Joe primarily paints landscapes where the light interests him, and with a good eye for detail he tries to capture the atmosphere and his feelings on a particular day.

He says 'I am inspired by the landscape but I am not a slave to it. Often she will show you little gems. These, along with compositions, I take, to utilise in my paintings. I am always mesmerised when the painting gradually appears on the paper as I paint. I hope I never lose that feeling. Paintings are developed from pencil tonal sketches and painted sketches. This preliminary work is an important first stage to get down what I see in my mind.'

He turned professional in 1993 and initially established himself by painting landscapes and farmsteads then selling his work to the farmers themselves. He is entirely self-taught and now enjoys teaching others. He also does demonstrations and workshops for art clubs/societies throughout the North East. He has had a number of exhibitions and his work is in many collections.
