Club Meeting: Wednesday 14th February 2024

Hartlepool Art Gallery, Christ Church, Church Square, Hartlepool, 7.00pm – 9.00pm (doors open 6.40pm).

We are pleased to welcome our own **Malcolm Davies**, who will give us a demonstration of the design and production of stained glass.

Malcolm started painting at school in the Midlands. Art has played a significant part in his life since then, continuing after his move to the North East in the mid 1970s. His earliest commissions of automotive subjects started in the late 70s and his work is found all around the globe, appearing in both car club and national car magazines. Until the late 90s he worked primarily with Acrylics but started working in Watercolour, his range of subjects expanding well beyond that of the automobile. Malcolm is a Full Member of the Guild of Railway Artists and an Associate Member of the Guild of Automotive Artists. He is a qualified teacher and has recently started teaching the subject of Urban Sketching.

Malcolm started working with stained glass in early 2023 and although new to the medium has already received a large number of commissions for his work.

There is a **£4 per head contribution**, to help pay for the accommodation and non-members are welcome. Please note that there is no tutor at most sessions, although we do sometimes hold workshops with renowned artists, when a higher contribution is payable, towards their fees. You will need to bring your own materials, although there is a limited stock of paints, pencils and paper, for people who fancy trying different media and help is willingly given by other members. It is a lively, friendly group and you can decide how long you care to stay.
