Tracey was born in Leeds and now lives in the Yorkshire Dales. From an early age she has had a fascination with painting and drawing. She left school with an A level in art, other than that she is self-taught and feels that this frees her up from the restrictions of a formal art education. She opened a small shop in her local town and sold her paintings and painted glassware. She moved to Australia where she had twin girls and returned to the U.K. 8 years later.

Over the years she has developed and practiced her art, learning techniques and methods from other artists and from books and has spent many hours in galleries studying different types of art work and media. Tracey has an eclectic taste in art and her portfolio shows many styles reflecting this. She is currently very much involved in teaching, workshops, and exhibitions and demonstrates at various art shows/venues throughout the country.

# 'Knot Twister Prologue' – Jim Moir (aka Vic Reeves), The Biscuit Factory, Stoddart Street, Newcastle, NE2 1AN

Following three successful exhibitions, including a sell-out show in 2019, artist, actor and comedian **Jim Moir** (aka Vic Reeves) returns to The Biscuit Factory in Newcastle with a brand new collection of artwork entitled Knot Twister Prologue. **Running until 20 July 2025**, this fourth solo exhibition at the Ouseburn-based gallery will showcase Moir's ongoing fascination with the natural world, with a particular focus on the birds and landmarks of the Northumbrian and North East region. Visitors can expect to see expressive new works featuring puffins, kittiwakes and other distinctive local species, alongside pieces that reflect Moir's signature surrealist and humorous style.
