#### **Club Treasurer**

Malcolm Davies has confirmed he will shortly be moving to Scotland (we wish him and wife Gillian all the best). As the Club needs a Treasurer, the Committee is pursuing the proposal to use an outside accountancy firm to provide the service until we find an alternative. We have been given a cost of £25 a month (£300 a year) to provide the service, which will include the annual audit of
